Fast for Hope (FFH) - Core Values

- **Core Values**: Commitments made by participants and program elements will incorporate these values that the program achieve.
 - **“Fostering and Accompaniment”**
 - by Rotary FFH and its partners to enable community capabilities
 - **“Comprehensive value”**
 - should meet the needs of the community as determined by the community itself and the viability of the goals
 - **“Sustainability”**
 - of successes by the community itself, both economically and culturally
 - **“Community Self Sufficiency”**
 - through community leadership and ownership of the program elements
 - **“Quality of the program”**
 - the participants share and show pride in the successes and the impact on the community
 - **“Active participation and support”**
 - by the Rotary Club(s) in the host country and District 5960

FFH - Mission Statement

Important Definitions:

NOTE: These are critical because these are the things fundamental to what we are doing, and we should be able to measure and clearly communicate the effectiveness and impact of what we are doing.

1. **Foster:**

- Planning and achievement of [growth by the community itself](#) and at the community's pace
- Community [Leadership development and effectiveness](#)
- [Accompaniment](#) of the community by Rotary and partners

2. **Extreme Poverty:**

- [Definition of extreme poverty](#) - scorecards / OI terms and metrics
- [Community input](#) into needs and wants
- Application of Maslow's hierarchy of [basic human needs](#)

3. **Sustainability:**

- Community's ability to [manage and maintain accomplishments themselves](#)
- Community [leadership's commitment to "own" the gains](#) and expand further development on their own
- Goal of having [Rotary's input of resources end](#) based on the community's accomplishments

4. **Replicable (additional for District strategy):**

- Creation of a [clear, basic model](#) by Rotary FFH that can be applied to other communities anywhere in the world
- [Development of partners](#) that will enable replication of the FFH model to other communities – gaining breadth, increasing impact
- Continuing [engagement of Rotarians within District, and at other Districts](#) that encourage and promote application of the FFH model to other communities
